It is an improvement on the previous year's result, raising by 10%, but are not as high as we were hoping. At Moorgate, we were very disappointed with these results. These reading results are why we have reading as a focus for our school improvement. We are looking at improving the children's ability to quickly read, identify and retrieve information from a text, and use this information to produce precise answers. We are focusing on this within school and working with other schools to bring about these improvements.

We are in line for writing with the National figures but are still looking at ways to improve this so that we can exceed those figures.

In mathematics, we are in line with the National figures.
